The Hospital was requesting \$46,000.00 to transport two children from the Dominican Republic. The patients in question were four and five-year-old children who had sustained severe scald injuries. I immediately contacted our Treasurer, Bob Baker to ensure that we had sufficient funds, and Illustrious Rob Havener for his approval to spend the funds. Minutes later, I was back on the phone to our hospital in Boston to inform them that Aleppo would pay all transportation costs (\$46,000.00), to get these kids to the care they desperately needed. It just so happens that Aleppo has a Shrine Club in the Dominican Republic.
