



Non-medical bystanders can help save lives by providing immediate bleeding control principles and aid until first responders arrive. Stop the Bleed is a FREE class offered by Aleppo Medical Corps. This class is open to any individual or group.

EACH PARTICIPANT RECEIVES: • Professional FREE hands-on training on blood loss techniques • Lecture by expert in the field • Information on how to obtain bleeding control kits.

Class Options:

1. **In Person:** The 2-hour long class is a combination of lectures and hands-on training on wound packing and tourniquet use to train, equip and empower the bystander in the critical first minutes after a trauma injury that causes bleeding.
2. **ONLINE:** This virtual course allows individuals to go through animated videos, diagrams, and quizzes. While the interactive course fulfills the lecture portion, it does not allow them to receive a certificate of completion until they complete the hands-on skills portion of the course. The interactive course will encourage participants to attend either a full STOP THE BLEED® Course or a Skills-Only STOP THE BLEED® Course to receive their certificate of completion. At the conclusion of the course, they will receive an email with their final quiz results. Participants must show the instructor this document to receive a certificate of completion after they have completed the skills-only portion of the course.
